GENERAL RULES

- **Participants must be UG/PG/PhD under the age of 25. They must present a valid physical Aadhar card and College ID during registration.**
- **Each university/college/institution is required to designate a "Contingent Leader" who will serve as the point of contact for Eklavya '26. The Contingent Leader will be responsible for all actions undertaken by the participants during the tournament.**
- **Every participant is obligated to carry their college ID and national ID card at all times. Adherence to Plaksha University's rules and regulations is mandatory for all participants and contingent members while on the premises.**
- **Plaksha maintains strict policies against Substance Abuse, Violence, and Sexual Harassment. Violations will result in disqualification from the event without a refund. The Plaksha Administration may take official action in collaboration with the participant's institution.**



GENERAL RULES

- **Participants and contingents must arrive at Plaksha University's Campus on 20th February 2026 before time (which will be informed closer to the date). Registration is mandatory including providing the ID card and two passport-size photographs.**
- **Participants are encouraged to bring their own water bottles in support of non-plastic movement at Plaksha.**

EVENT RULES:

- All general FIFA laws will be followed unless specified by the referee.
- Full field (95m x 65m) 11-a-side match
- The minimum team size is 14 and maximum is 18 players
- Each half will be 25 mins with 10 min breaks.



FOOTBALL

PRIZE POOL

EVENT RULES:

- All general FIFA laws will be followed unless specified by the referee.
- Minimum squad size of 7 and the maximum of 9 players.
- 5-a-side match with a field size of 35m x 25m.
- Each half will be 10 mins with 5 min breaks.



BASKETBALL

EVENT RULES:

- All FIBA rules will be followed.
- The referee's call is final.
- Minimum 7 and maximum 12 players in a team.
- Each quarter will last 10 minutes.
- Teams must be present at the venue at least 20 minutes prior to their scheduled match. At least 5 players should be present at the start time of the match failing to do so will result in a walkover.



BASKETBALL

EVENT RULES:

- All FIBA rules will be followed.
- The referee's call is final.
- Minimum 7 and maximum 12 players in a team.
- Each quarter will last 10 minutes.
- Teams must be present at the venue at least 20 minutes prior to their scheduled match. At least 5 players should be present at the start time of the match failing to do so will result in a walkover.



VOLLEYBALL

EVENT RULES:

- **FIVB rules will be followed and referee's decision will be final.**
- **Each team can have a minimum 8 and maximum 12 players.**
- **Matches will be played in fixed positions.**
- **Initial round matches will be played in a best-of-3 sets format.**
- **Each set will go up to 25 points (rally scoring), with a 2-point lead required to win, in case of a tie (1-1), the third set will be played up to 15 points.**
- **Each team is allowed 2 timeouts per set, lasting 1 minute each.**
- **Breaks between sets will last 2-3 minutes**
- **A 10-15 minute gap will be observed between matches.**

- Matches will be played in fixed positions.

- Each set will go up to 25 points (rally scoring), with a 2-point lead required to win, in case of a tie (1-1), the third set will be played up to 15 points.
- Each team is allowed 2 timeouts per set, lasting 1 minute each.

- A 10-15 minute gap will be observed

- Only two player per team is allowed to play two matches of different types (one Singles and one Doubles).
- Players must report at the venue 15 minutes prior to the scheduled match time.
- Non-marking shoes and proper sports attire are mandatory.

- Each set will be played to 11 points.
- League matches will be best of 3 sets, while semifinals and finals will be best of 5.

- Minimum 2 and maximum 4 players.
- Each set will be played to 11 points.
- League matches will be best of 3 sets, while semifinals and finals will be best of 5.



CHESS

EVENT RULES:

- FIDE Rapid Chess rules.
- Team Composition: 4 players per round + 1 substitute (optional).
- Tournament Format: Swiss-system pairing.
- Time Control : 25 min + 10 sec
- Tiebreak : 3 min + 2 sec for tied teams.
- Arbiter's Decision is final and binding.

For the accommodation of the athletes, we recommend the following conveniently located and well-appointed options.

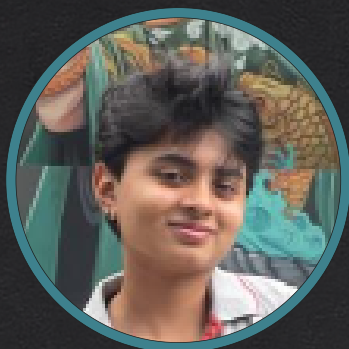
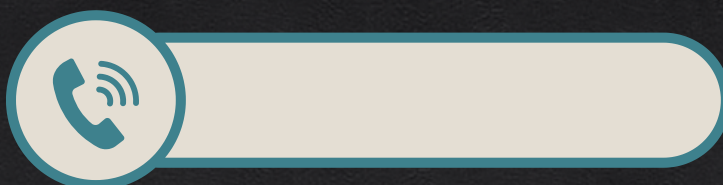
